AUN/SEED-Net Network

AUN/SEED-Net is mainly supported by the Japanese Government through the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), and partially supported by the ASEAN Foundation.

ASEAN University Network (AUN) in April 2001 (AUN/SEED-Net) aimed at promoting human resources development in engineering in ASEAN. To date the Network consists of 26 leading Member Institutions from 10 ASEAN countries with the support of 14 leading Japanese Supporting Universities.

Our faculty is a members of AUN/SEED since 2003. As a Member Institution we need to produce graduates with master's and doctoral degrees of international standard in the engineering field. We are required to produce master's degrees and doctoral degrees in a Sandwich Program with Japanese Supporting Universities.
