

Entry Requirements

- General entry requirements:

The entry requirements for the Master of Engineering (Environmental Management) program are as follows:

- i) A Bachelor's degree in a science and technology-related field or its equivalent recognized by the University Senate; AND
- ii) A Bachelor's degree or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.50/4.00;
OR
- iii) A Bachelor's degree or its equivalent with a minimum CGPA of 2.00/4.00 but less than 2.50/4.00 must have five (5) years of relevant work experience.

- Postgraduate Student English Language Competency Requirements:

a) Local Students:

English language competency is not required.

b) International Students:

International students who wish to pursue postgraduate studies at UTM must meet the following English language competency requirements:

- i) Malaysian University Entrance Test (MUET) with a minimum score of Band 4.0 or higher; or
- ii) IELTS with a minimum score of Band 6.0 or higher; or
- iii) TOEFL iBT with a minimum score of 60 or higher; or
- iv) Cambridge English Qualifications (CEQ) B2 First (FCE), C1 Advanced (CAE), C2 Proficiency (CPE), with a minimum score of 168 or higher; or

v) Pearson Test of English (PTE) Academic with a minimum score of 59 or higher; or

vi) Certified Intensive English Programme Level (CIEP Level) with a minimum score of 109 or higher.

Exemptions to English language requirements may be granted to international students from countries where English is the official language or international students who have obtained academic qualifications from institutions where English is used as the medium of instruction and intend to pursue higher studies in Malaysia.

International students who do not meet the language requirements may enroll in the Intensive English Programme (IEP) at UTM Language Academy or the Certified Intensive English Program (CIEP) at any ELS Language Center in Malaysia for up to one year from the date of registration.

Upon completion, students must sit for the MUET or any of the exams listed in points (i) to (v) to qualify for admission to the main study program at UTM.

- Prerequisite Courses:

There are no prerequisite course requirements for applicants who do not meet the criteria.

- APEL (T-7) Entry Requirements:

This program accepts applicants with the Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL) certification for entry into the Master's program (APEL T-7) in Environmental Management.

- Admission Requirements for Students with Disabilities (PWD):

The program accepts students with physical disabilities under the following conditions:

Candidates with physical disabilities that do not hinder practical work can be admitted to this program.
